

School Closures

Our school plans to remain open in all but the most exceptional circumstances. Examples of a school closure may be localised flooding or adverse weather conditions such as snow. However, if it is necessary to close or partially close our school the procedure will be as follows:

The Headteacher will consider the local circumstances and specific issues relating to the school. It is his decision whether to close the school. This decision will be made as early as possible (usually by 7am) so that information can be passed to the radio stations and website below and broadcast to the public
